FROM BISHOP DOLAN

My dear Friends,

As if the world, the flesh, and the devil were not enough, Ratzinger's resignation, followed by the Bergoglio imbroglio, threatened to distract us during our Lent, the holiest days of the year.

However, we are not of the Conciliar Church, nor were we ever. Our Church is built on Peter's unfailing rock. This perspective provides great serenity and peace, even as the Novus Ordo world gets itself a true Novus Ordo pope. (Well, no, he doesn't even call himself a pope!)

"Call me Jorge," he says. Fair enough. We could call him anything but Catholic. This Vatican II Jesuit, not even a valid priest, is steeped in the heresies of that false Council. The head heresy is Ecumenism, which explains the destruction of doctrine and worship, of truth and beauty, of the Catholic Church almost everywhere throughout the world.

I write to you today, on Easter Friday, when the Church commemorates the great "Angel of Judgement," St. Vincent Ferrer, one of the glories of the Spanish speaking world. This Dominican preacher was raised up during the Great Western Schism to save souls. Boldly he went into synagogues to preach Jesus Christ, and converted at least 25,000 Jews in Spain alone. Some 8,000 "unconvertible" Mohammedans even fell before Vincent's holy eloquence, as well as innumerable schismatics, sinners, and heretics.

Firmly rooted in the faith, St. Vincent burned with holy charity for souls. Compare this canonized Dominican with that Modernist Jesuit who lights Hanukkah candles, washes the feet of Moslem girls, is blessed by Pentecostal preachers, and *urges* Anglicans *not* to convert. St. Vincent was a true Catholic; Bergoglio is a perfect Vatican II imposter. The Novus Ordo should be happy indeed. He does not even trouble to hide his heresy under lace and lovely vestments.
